# Clinician availability

Urgent appointments - Langham Place Surgery has joined a pilot study called DoctorLink – an online tool that enables you to answer a series of questions about your condition. It will then signpost you to the most appropriate pathway for example, self-help, or to see or speak to a clinician. The information will be reviewed by a clinician at the surgery and we will contact you to arrange an appointment if one is needed. Please visit our website www.langhamplacesurgery.co.uk and use DoctorLink for all urgent appointments. These appointments may be with our lead nurse or one of our paramedics.

You can view, book and cancel your future appointments by logging on to our online service. You can manage your appointments quickly and easily wherever you are, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. In order to use this online service you must first register to receive your unique username and password. Please visit our website to do this.

When booking an appointment if you wish to see a particular doctor we will do our best to accommodate your request depending on availability.

# Results of investigations

Please ring the surgery after 11.00am. It is important that you check the results of any tests or investigations you have had done. Please do not assume the result is normal.

# Repeat prescriptions

Repeat prescriptions may be requested via our online service, by post or in person. Please allow 48 hours (excluding weekends and bank holidays) for standard repeat items, 72 hours for items not authorised on repeat and at least a week for postal prescriptions (SAE to be enclosed): www.langhamplacesurgery.co.uk

We also use the electronic prescription service (EPS). Please ask reception for details.

#### Home visits

Home visits are made when the doctor feels it is necessary on medical grounds. You can greatly assist by attending the surgery whenever possible. If you are too ill to come to the surgery, please try to telephone before 10:30am. Please give as much detail as possible about the problem so the doctor can judge how urgent the visit is.

## Minor Surgery

The doctors carry out some minor surgical procedures at the practice. Please ask the Doctor for advice.

# **Practice Nurses**

Practice Nurse appointments can be pre booked for the following: Chronic disease management clinics (e.g. diabetes, asthma and coronary heart disease), family planning advice, smears, weight management, ear syringing, travel advice, injections and smoking cessation advice. They also run a Minor Illness Clinic (see separate paragraph for details).

# **Health Care Assistants**

Our Health Care Assistants undertake: Blood pressure checks, ECGs, blood tests, urine tests, general health checks - MOT's, new patient checks and weight monitoring.

# **District Nursing Team**

Patients who need nursing assistance at home may arrange, through their doctor, for a District Nurse to call. The District Nurses may be contacted for advice by telephoning 0300 7770002 between 8.00am and 10.00pm. Out of these hours please dial 111 to speak the NHS 111 service. The District Nurses also offer information and support for the elderly and for carers.

# **Maternity Medical Services**

Maternity medical services are provided by each doctor in conjunction with a Community Midwife. Arrangements are made for delivery in the GP Unit at Northampton General Hospital. Please enquire about antenatal appointments.

# **Health Visitors**

We have a 2 Health Visitors and 1 Nursery Nurse attached to the Practice.

You may speak to the team by phoning the Central Hub on 0300 1111022 between 9.00am and 5.00pm.

# Counselling service

The surgery provides a counselling service via our Wellbeing Team for patients with stress related problems. Patients can be referred to this service by their GP.

# Health Checks

These are available for all patients. In addition, for those aged 75 or over, where owing to a medical condition it would be impossible to attend the surgery, this can be undertaken at home.

# Special Services available

Services outside the scope of the NHS are available on request but will attract a fee.

# Disabled access and parking

Wheelchair access can be gained from the rear of the building but general patient parking is at the front. You may park immediately outside the front of the building after 9:30am, where access is possible with assistance. Please inform reception in advance if you feel you may need help on arrival.

There are facilities for patients on three floors (lower, ground and first floor). A lift is available for the lower floor but the first floor may only be accessed via a staircase. Please inform reception if you have difficulty with stairs.

# Volunteer transport service

There is a community transport service provided by volunteers. It is for medically related problems for elderly and disabled people who live in the borough of Northampton and who cannot manage public services. There is a small charge and transport must be arranged at least 2 days before you want to travel. For more information, please telephone 01604 628234 between 9:00am and 12 noon on weekdays.
